An initiative offering secondary school students an opportunity to gain authentic and practical experience through an introduction to the building and construction industry. HIA youthBuild is industry focused, and in consultation with Department of Education, Children and Young People, curriculum aligned.

Who can participate

Due to generous ongoing support from Keystone Tasmania, HIA youthBuild is available to students enrolled in a Tasmanian school for Year 9 and 10 and is free to participate.





What trades can be completed?

A range of hands-on learning opportunities and projects are available including, but not limited to the following trades:

Carpentry and joinery, bricklaying, landscaping, design, plastering, and finishing trades (painting, tiling, etc.)

Where are the projects completed?
